Length of term has traditionally been one year

GSR is also the Delegate

LI Coda has been sending Delegates steadily from NY since 2019
David suggested he will reach out to meetings (mainly in person) and contacts in the rest of the state to encourage them to send a Delegate

Coda is not offering scholarships for delegates due to financial constraints of the board
The CSC is live and on zoom this year and will be on Zoom starting 2026
The CSC is followed by the ICC - International Coda Convention - in person in Philadelphia
The ICC in 2026 will be in Arizona- celebrating the 40th anniversary

Delegate for 2025 CSC:

Linda nominated David and he was voted in, with further online confirmation by members later on

Proposal made to give Delegate a stipend of \$250 from LI coda, which passed

Workshop subcommittee to put on an event by Heartfelt Humility was proposed to be affiliated with LI coda- not seconded

There was discussion about the motion 24063 passed last year regarding no outside literature in meetings
